TERMS & CONDITIONS

VISITING MARES FOR INSEMINATION

LIVERY RATES

Grass livery £5 per day

Stabled – full livery £12 per day

If feeds are to be supplied to keep condition on a mare whilst in the field and extra £1 per feed will be charged

Any additional supplements to be fed should be supplied by the owner when the mare arrives at stud along with written instructions on their administration.

CONDITIONS OF LIVERY & INSEMINATION OF MARES VISITING THE STUD

1. All owners or agents bringing visiting mares to the stud must fill in and sign a booking in form on arrival. Any relevant behavioural traits MUST be informed to us at that time
2. It is a legal requirement that all mares visiting the stud have to be accompanied by their passport. This passport will be returned to the owner when the mare is collected
3. Only mares that have clean swab results or blood tests for strangles (*streptococcus equi*) within the last 28 days will be allowed direct access to our fields. A mandatory 2 week quarantine period stabled at full livery is necessary for all without the above unless we have confirmation that the mare has not been moved from its home yard within the 2 weeks prior to arrival and that the home yard has been free from strangles during that time. The costs for full livery during this period are as above.
4. All mares will be wormed on arrival and have a settling period stabled before they are allowed access to the field. Mare owners are liable for the costs of wormers used unless they supply their own wormer on arrival.
5. Lambridden Stud reserve the right to remove a mare from our field without the agreement of the owner. This will be carried out in

circumstances where it is deemed either dangerous for the mare to be in the field for her sake or the sake of others in the field or if it serves her health a well-being more to be stabled.

6. Whilst we endeavour to provide the best levels of care and attention for mares visiting us, Lambridden Stud accepts no responsibility for any accident, injury, disease or illness that may arise whilst the mare is on site. Any veterinary costs or damage liabilities are the sole responsibility of the owner.
7. All visiting mares entering the field at Lambridden should have their back shoes removed preferably before arrival. Any other fees associated with farriery etc are the sole responsibility of the owner.
8. Any veterinary care necessary for the well-being of the horse which is deemed necessary by Lambridden Stud will be carried out and fees will be the responsibility of the owner. Whenever possible, the owner will be contacted before care which will incur added costs is carried out but the immediate well-being of the horse will always be the first priority.
9. Any mares to be conventionally covered at the stud should be accompanied by a current clean swab certificate. These swabs can be taken by our on-site vet at the stud and sent away for analysis but it would avoid unnecessary time for the mare being at stud if this was carried out before arrival.
10. Our on-site vet will carry out all veterinary work deemed necessary for the health and well-being of your mare. In the unlikely event that outside veterinary attention is required, the charges for these services will be billed to the owner directly from the veterinary service provider.

MARES WITH FOALS AT FOOT

1. All foals visiting the stud have to have a current tetanus vaccination and will be wormed as per our own programme at the stud. Vaccinations will be kept up to date at the owners request and will be payable by the owner.
2. Whilst we endeavour to provide the best levels of care and attention for mares and foals visiting us, Lambridden Stud accepts no responsibility for any accident, injury, disease or illness that may arise whilst the mare and foal is on site. Any veterinary costs or damage liabilities are the sole responsibility of the owner.

MARES TO FOAL AT STUD

1. Mares will be accepted for foaling at a charge of £100 per week. The mare should be transported within plenty of time of her due date to avoid the stress of travel affecting the pregnancy. DVDs can normally be supplied of the foaling for the owner if requested.
2. Whilst we endeavour to provide the best levels of care and attention for mares during foaling, Lambridden Stud accepts no

responsibility for any accident, injury, that may arise during the process. Any veterinary costs or damage liabilities are the sole responsibility of the owner.

VET CHARGES

1. Vet charges per insemination cycle are £120 for chilled inseminations and £200 for frozen inseminations
2. The package for an insemination cycle includes all scanning for follicle and ovulation and a pregnancy diagnosis at 14-16 days, all hormone drugs to induce cycle and ovulation and any manual twin reduction. It does not include for any other treatment deemed necessary in order to induce pregnancy including lavages, swabbing, treatment for infections etc.

PAYMENT

1. Payment for stud fees is due before insemination of the mare and should be paid in full on the arrival of the mare at stud
2. There are charges associated with the shipping and health papers for each dose of semen that is imported into the UK. These are £100 per dose for chilled semen and £150 for the first dose of frozen semen then £50 per dose thereafter.
3. Any charges for livery, vets fees and additional charges are payable before the mare leaves the stud. Mare owners who send a third party to collect their mares should settle up prior to this or arrange payment to be made by the third party. Interest will be charged on any monies outstanding at a rate of 2 ½ % per month

LAMBRIDDEN STUD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO ANY MARE IN THE EVENT THAT THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ABOVE ARE NOT COMPLIED WITH

OFF-YARD INSEMINATIONS

1. A booking form must be completed and signed for all mares to be inseminated. This can be downloaded from our downloads section of the website and can either be faxed, posted or e-mailed to us at Lambridden.
2. All frozen semen sold is NOT for re-sale
3. Only ONE mare can be inseminated with each delivery of chilled semen unless more than one dose is ordered by the breeder. (Some stallions have 2 doses of semen per insemination)

PAYMENTS

4. Payment for stud fees is due before the mare is inseminated and should be paid in full on booking
5. Costs associated with shipping and health papers are as follows: £100 per dose for chilled semen and for frozen semen, £150 for the first dose, then £120 for subsequent doses for the same mare

HEALTH PAPERS

6. All semen imported will be accompanied by the relevant health papers. Notification of the arrival of the semen and transfer of these health papers will be carried out by Lambridden Stud

ORDERING

7. Orders can be made from Monday to Thursday for semen deliveries on Tuesday to Fridays. Saturday deliveries for chilled semen can be arranged in extraordinary cases but the cost of

this is usually very prohibitive and will be at least £300 per delivery. For frozen semen, provided the semen is in stock at Lambridden, this can be arranged providing the order is made by 9am on the day before.

8. Orders for chilled semen have to be made BEFORE 8AM the morning prior to needing the semen. After this time, no guarantee of next day delivery can be given
9. Chilled semen is provided for use on only one mare and one dose will be provided for each insemination cycle.
10. For chilled and frozen semen terms and conditions for imported semen, see the relevant terms and conditions for the stallion's home stud which are supplied on our site in the downloads section.
11. Please note that there are a few bank holidays which influence the collection and transportation of semen. These can be found on the internet for the country from which the semen is to be exported.
12. For frozen semen deliveries, the shipping charges cover for the return of the flask. This will be arranged for the day after delivery whenever possible and the semen should be transferred to a holding tank on delivery. A charge of £30 per day will be applied if the flask is not ready for collection.

SEMEN DETAILS

1. Lambridden Stud is not responsible for the condition and quality of imported semen. Any queries relating to problems in this area will be taken up with the stud by Lambridden and any responses forwarded to the client.
2. Lambridden take no responsibility for the late delivery of semen due to transport issues or for any orders which have been lost in transit. Any claims should be made directly to the shipping company.
3. Lambridden is not liable for any mis-labelling or incorrect health papers in relation to imported semen
4. Imported semen is subject to the terms and conditions of the exporting stud – Terms and conditions for Stal Eurocommerce and Schockemoehle can be found in the downloads section of the website
5. Refunds for mares not in foal are subject to the terms and conditions of the particular stud from where the semen has been imported
6. Semen from Eurocommerce Berlin can only be sold per straw for off-yard inseminations. The minimum order is 10 straws, although these straws can be used on more than one mare. Stud fee terms DO NOT apply if the mare is not in foal – no refunds are available. If the mare is brought to Lambridden for insemination, the stud fee benefits are available as is the choice of using chilled semen on your mare.
7. Chilled semen can be used from Eurocommerce Berlin on yard at Lambridden – this will be drawn on Monday, Wednesday and Friday and will therefore be available on Tuesdays and Thursday, with a possibility of a Saturday delivery (although very expensive at around £300 per delivery)
8. All frozen semen from Deckstation Schockemoehle is sold per dose and no refunds are available for a mare not in foal.
9. For stallions standing at lambridden, a no foal free return contract is offered. This allows the breeder to bring back to mare if she is not in foal with no additional charge for the stud fee.

- This free return is not transferable to another owner but can be used on another mare owned by the breeder if desired. The no foal free return offered covers the foal until it is 5 days old.
10. It is the responsibility of the breeder to ensure that insemination dates are passed on to Lambridden Stud before 1st October to allow a covering certificate to be applied for. For mares not in foal, a letter from the veterinary surgeon who has carried out the pregnancy diagnosis should reach us also before 1st October to allow any refunds or vouchers to be processed.

HOLIDAY VOUCHERS

1. A £100 holiday voucher will be given for every 2 mares brought to stud by the same breeder. The terms and conditions of these vouchers can be found in the downloads section of the website.
